This day came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon came a jury to wit James D Westbrook, James Bell, George McCaump, James W Doyal, Hanson D Moore, Mills Sumner, James Williams, John A Sumner, Augustus W Williams, Nathan D Bryant & Benjamin E Pope who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the oaths joined upon their oath returned a verdict in the following words to wit: "We of the jury find for the plaintiff the debt in the declaration mentioned with int. from the 1st of October 1831 until paid." Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant the sum of Twenty five dollars the debt in the declaration mentioned with legal Interest thereon from the 1st day of October 1831 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended. To be levied of the goods and chattels of the defendant in the hands of the defendant to be administered. And the said Defendant in Mercy &c. This judgement is to be credited for ten dollars paid January 26th 1836.
