

To Joshua Howard conveying a tract of land containing 160 acres more or less was passed in the Clerks Office the 1st November 1841 by one of the witnesses thereunto and having been passed in the Office on the 16th August 1841 by two other witnesses thereto and acknowledged in the Office on the 26th day of same month by one of the parties thereto was together with the Certificate of the Survey examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Power of Attorney from Benjamin Edmunds to William H Edmunds was intimated together with the Certificate admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Benjamin Edmunds by his attorney in fact William H Edmunds to John Parkhouse conveying a tract of land containing 200 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 29th day of November 1841 by William H Edmunds and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Sterling A Lewis and Sally C his wife to Daniel W Simonsen conveying a tract of land containing 189 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 4th day of December 1841 by Sterling A Lewis and together with the Certificate annexed of the Survey examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Daniel W Simonsen and Rebecca his wife of the first part, William H Simonsen of the second part and Sterling A Lewis of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 189 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 4th December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and together with the Certificate of the Survey examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between the Peterborough & Newcastle Rail Road Company of the first part, John A. Chamberlain, Richard H Chamberlain and Jaywells Taylor of the second part and the Mayor, Recorder, Alderman and Common Council of the Borough of Stamford of the third part conveying real and personal estate was passed in the Clerks Office on the 7th day of December 1841 by all the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James Thorne of the first part John D Thorne of the second part and Joseph T Gale and others of the third part conveying 1 horse, 16 cattle, one two yearling increased, 70 hens and their further increase, one buffaloe, one double gig carriage, one single gig carriage, 2 carts & wheel, 1 priddle, 200 barrels of Corn, 14 stacks blade fodder, and one Stock of oats, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 14th day of December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between James Thorne of the first part, Nicholas Brown of the second part and John D Thorne of the third part conveying 1 horse, 16 head of cattle, 70 head of hogs, one buffaloe, one double gig carriage, one single gig carriage, 2 carts and wheels, one priddle, 200 barrels of corn, 14 stacks blade fodder and one Stock of oats, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 14th December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

An Account of Jacob Lewis guardianship of Louisa Lewis was then lay returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Benjamin Griffin, Ordered that Silvester R Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose State, settle and adjust an account of Benjamin Griffin to be accounted as Curator of Gates Bazaar and make report thereof to Court.
