Liles and others of the third part conveying 7 horses, 16 cattle, and their future increase, 70 hogs and their future increase, one buffalo, one longlegged and hump, one single gig thump, 2 carts & wheels, 1 saddle, 200 barrels of corn, 14 stacks of clover fodder, and one stack of oats, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 14th day of December 1861 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between James Sherod of the first part, Nicholas Barn of the second part and John D. Sherod of the third part conveying 16 head of horses, 16 head of cattle, 70 head of hogs, one buffalo, one longlegged and hump, one single gig thump, 2 carts and wheels, one saddle, 200 barrels of corn, 14 stacks of clover fodder and one stack of oats, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th December 1861 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.
