Coper of the second part and Henry Knicker of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 91 3/4 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th December 1841 by all the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John P. Price executor of Joseph Blount deceased to John P. Henry conveying a tract of land containing 180 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th of December 1841 by Bennett J. Griffin and together with the certificate of the saying examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Albert W. Dransell of the first part, Alfred J. Stephenson of the second part and Allen Stephenson of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 75 acres more or less, one small house, 9 sheats, 2 cows, 1 cart and wheels, crop of corn and feed, one feather bed and furniture, and all the remainder of his household and kitchen furniture was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Howell G. Scarborough to John W. Sellen conveying a tract of land containing 1440 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by Howell G. Scarborough and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Hendric Jackson of the first part, James R. Jones of the second part and James Jackson of the third part conveying One small house, 1 Cow more or less, 1 Cow, 22 head of cattle, 35 head of hogs, 3 shot guns, 3 pair of cart wheels, 6 feather beds, Saddle of horse and all his household and kitchen furniture, miscellaneous Stocks and crops for the next year, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th of December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

At Deed of bargain and sale from Mills C. Lawrence and Rebecca Crumpler to George W. Crumpler conveying a tract of land containing 120 acres more or less, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20th December 1841 by Mills C. Lawrence one of the parties thereto and admitted to record as to him.

Deed of bargain and sale from Mills C. Lawrence to William Lawrence conveying
