Pepe of the second part and Henry Kniblock of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 21 1/4 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by all the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John J. Pennington executor of Joseph Blanton deceased to John J. D. Pennington conveying a tract of land containing 5 1/2 acres more or less was recorded in the Clerks Office was recorded in the Clerks Office on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1841 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before recorded in said Office on the 13<sup>th</sup> of the same month by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Matthew Willms and Elizabeth his wife and Dorothy Willms to Henry Jones conveying a tract of land containing 18 acres and 2 rods more or less was recorded in the Clerks Office on the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by all the witnesses thereto and together with the certificate of the survey examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Bennett J. Griffin and Susanna his wife to James H. Cherry conveying a tract of land containing 180 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by Bennett J. Griffin and together with the certificate of the survey examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of trust between Elliott W. Drane of the first part, Alfred J. Stephenson of the second part and Allen Stephenson of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 25 acres more or less, one stone house, 9 shrouds, 2 pens, 1 cart and wheels, crop of corn and fodder, one feather bed and furniture, and all the remainder of his household and kitchen furniture was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Howell G. Scobrough to John W. Miller conveying a tract of land containing 14 1/2 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by Howell G. Scobrough and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Leonard Jackson of the first part, James R. Jones of the second part and James Jackson of the third part conveying One dovel house, 1 Cowm more, 9 Cows, fifty 22 head of cattle, 35 head of hogs, 2 shot guns, 2 pair of Cart wheels, 6 feather beds, Saddle of horse and all his household and kitchen furniture, mireblades, sickles and crop for current year, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

A Deed of bargain and sale from Hills & Lawrence and Colenon Brumfield to George W. Brumfield conveying a tract of land containing 120 acres more or less, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1841 by Hills & Lawrence one of the parties thereto and admitted to Record as to him.
