

Survey of Samuel & H Bonds land surveyed to Patrick H Rollings & Arthur A Dowry, made the 4th of August 1841, under an order of Court for allotting to the widow of Patrick Bonds die^r her dower, commencing at a stone at the mouth of the Spring Lane (so called) a corner in the line and W. L. Woods lot, and running N 2 W 79.44 poles to a white oak, thence N S E 32.28, a pole N S W 80 to a parallel perpendicular lot in Dover, & 7th M. St. 68, a perpendicular N S W 69.32, 44 a red oak lot, then Springs fence in Woods line N 28 E 33.20 a pole S 59 E 42.44 a red oak lot, then Spring N 42 E 100.74 N. oak lot S 75 E 10.12 N. O. thence a line of marked trees to a Marsh, thence down S. Branch to a Bl. gum a corner in Hollis line thence N 78 E 11.58 a red oak lot, near A. Hutchins fence thence S 15 E 77.08 a pole in branch in Rollers line S 21 M 12.56 a pole lot in Woods line in a branch, thence along S. Branch to a Bl. gum, thence up a branch to a pine, thence to a Bl. gum on edge of a meadow, a lot in down, thence up the meadow to a pine near road, thence S 4 E 33.28 to a red oak on Road, thence along said road to the beginning, containing 406 1/2 acres, of which was allotted to widow by commissioners by order -
