The Court doth adjudge Margaret A. R. Hart guardian to Elizabeth Hart orphan of Buffon Hart deceased and whereupon she said Margaret A. R. Hart with wife Elizabeth and Thomas J. Dunn right his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twelve hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

The Court doth adjudge Francis M. Boykin guardian to Master Ann Henry, Atticoe Virginia. Frances M. and Daniel F. Boykin infant children of the said Francis M. Boykin and therewith also said Francis M. Boykin with James Johnson his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Burwell bridge across Blackwater river the day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: Agreed upon the amount and order on the undersigned Commissioners proceeded in conjunction with Commissioners appointed on behalf of Isle of Wight to let the repairs & extension of Burwell bridge after giving timely notice thereof and Patrick Dobb one of the Commissioners became the undertaker for the sum of two hundred & eighty eight dollars - the work has been completed and we have received the same - Given under our hands this 1st day of December 1844. Ordered that the Sheriff pay unto Patrick Dobb the sum levied for him at June Court last for the repairs of Burwell bridge.
