

On the motion of James Massey who made oath and together with Jeph Luskford, James W. Massey and Miles W. Lawrence his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Sarah Massey dec'd in due form.

Ordered that James D. Hopfening, Edward Brumple, Jordan Edwards, and James W. Massey or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Sarah Massey dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands & seals.

On the motion of James Turner who made oath and together with John G. Turner and Silas Eldorado his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Mills Faircloth dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Edward Deaton, William D. Phillips, Sophia Gardner and Everett Bryant or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Mills Faircloth dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands & seals.

The Court doth assign Margaret A. Hart guardian to Elizabeth Elkins orphan of Buffum Hart deceased, and thereupon she said Margaret A. Hart with Jeph Luskford and Thomas J. Deming her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

The Court doth assign Francis M. Weyman guardian to Hester Ann, Mary, Rebecca Virginia, Francis M. and Sarah F. Weyman infant children of the said Francis M. Weyman, and thereupon she said Francis M. Weyman with James Johnson his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Russell's bridge across Black water river this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded, and is in these words to wit: "Agreeable to the annual order of the undersigned Commissioners proceeded in execution with the Commissioners appointed on the part of State to let the repairs & extension of Russell's bridge after giving timely notice thereof and Patrick Doherty one of the Commissioners became the undertaker for the sum of two hundred & eighty eight dollars - the work has been completed and we have received the same - Given under our hands this 11th day of December 1846. Jas. Weyman."

Ordered that the Sheriff pay unto Patrick Doherty the sum loaned for him at James Bank last for the repairs of Russell's bridge.
