Deed of trust between John Drury of the first part Arthur A Drury of the second part and William D Board of the third part conveying a slave and personal property was provided to the Office on the 10th of March 1842 by Charles Bright, Henry J Drury and Maria Drury Subscribing witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from John Higgins to John Higgins concerning personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 10th day of March 1842 by John Higgins and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Edwin Daskal and James A Royal of the first part L R Edwards of the second part and F J Mahone & James J Dwyer & Co of the third part conveying the said estate of Royal while stock of goats cows and merchandise then in hand was acknowledged in the Office on the 16th of March 1842 by Daskal Royal Edwards and Mahone and Dwyer and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John Drury of the first part L R Edwards of the second part and Edward Patis, Benjamin Dowling, Thomas Bellis and Benjamin Griffin of the third part conveying a slave and personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 18th March 1842 by Dowling Bellis and Edwards three of the parties thereto are admitted to Record.
