

Deed of bargain and sale from William Williams to Henry Ketchum for land was acknowledged in the Office on the 21st day of February 1842 by William Williams and admitted to record.

Deed of Release from S R Edwards and James S Finch to Samuel Wallace releasing land was acknowledged in the Office on the 22^d of February 1842 by Edwards and Finch and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Samuel Wallace to William Cobb for land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 22^d February 1842 by Samuel Wallace and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Frances M Boykin and wife, Elizabeth Briggs and son and James Johnson and wife to John Cobb for land was acknowledged in the Office on the 22^d February 1842 by James Johnson and having been acknowledged in the Office on the 16th December 1839 by Frances M Boykin and Elizabeth Briggs parties thereto was together with the certificates of the jury exonerations of the wives admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between David Stewart of the first part, John R Mason of the second part and Thomas H Fells Sr of the third part conveying slaves together with all the property previously conveyed in a deed of Trust to James M Davis for the benefit of John M Davis was acknowledged in the Office on the 25th February 1842 by Stewart and Mason and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between John A Sumner of the first part Henry Briggs and Matthew Harris of the third part conveying personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 25th February 1842 by Sumner and Harris and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Samuel J James and Sarah his wife of the first part S R Edwards of the second part and Samuel B Hines of the third part conveying land and slaves was returned to the Office on the 26th February 1842 and together with the certificates thereto annexed of the acknowledgments of the said James and wife before two Justices of the Peace admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Samuel J James and Sarah his wife of the first part S R Edwards of the second part and Samuel B Hines of the third part conveying land was returned to the Office on the 26th February 1842 and together with the certificates thereto annexed of the acknowledgments of the said James and wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Jesse Drury of the first part, William A Drury of the second part and William A Drury of the third part conveying a slave and personal property was provided in the Office on the 1st of March 1842 by Charles Wright, Henry S Pope and Anne Drury subscribing witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from John Higgins to John Higgins conveying personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 10th day of March 1842 by John Higgins and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Edward DeLoach and James H Royal of the first part S R Edwards of the second part and F J Mathews & James S Woodard Sr of the third part conveying the said stock & Royals white stock of goods wares and merchandise then on hand was acknowledged in the Office on the 16th of March 1842 by a DeLoach & Royal Edwards and Mathews and Mathews and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Jesse Drury of the first part, S R Edwards of the second part and Edward Davis, Benjamin Drury, Thomas Fells and Benjamin Griffin of the third part conveying a slave and personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 16th March 1842 by Drury Davis and Edwards thereto of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
