The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report which is in these words "February 15<sup>th</sup> 1842. In pursuance of a decree of the Court of Southampton signed at its February term in John D'Waltham, Samuel H. Holme, P. H. Dailey and R. A. Vaughan divided the lands late the property of Lucy and Polly Lewis with his equal parts, by running a direct line from a felled pine formerly a side line of the mansion tract to a blackwood post at the head of a bottom a side line between the mansion tract and Charles land, cutting off from the mansion tract and adding to the red house tract two rows apple trees giving thereby about thirty acres of the mansion tract to the red house tract. He further subject the red house tract to supply the mansion tract annually with enough pence timber to split one thousand rails for the repairing and keeping up the inclosure of the mansion tract. He the aforesaid Commissioners do agree to Joshua Proffit in his next right the mansion tract and to the heirs of the late Isid Proffit or all the red house tract, whose tract nowise is by the last will and Testament of the late Isid Proffit known to his widow during her life. In witness whereof we have here set our hands this day and date above written. John D'Waltham, Paul H. Holme, P. H. Dailey, R. A. Vaughan."
