

March 21st 1842. Peter D. Westmore Commissioner. This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof and it appearing to the Court that it is likely that other debts may yet come against the estate of Lucy Annson dec^d. it is ordered, adjudged and decreed that the legatee of said estate, shall upon the receipt of three legacies execute to the Executor refusing bonds in usual form of law. And that the Commissioner hand over to Robert Ritchie and Daniel Lyon bondsmen of John W. Slaughter and wife, bonds to the amount of one half of one seventh of the amount of said sales exclusive of costs of suit.

The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report in these words to wit: "Enclosed herewith is a list of the estate of Arthur Middleton dec^d to Sarah Liles late widow of Arthur Middleton dec^d in trust for life as dower of the slaves and real estate of which said Arthur Middleton dec^d died seized and possessed and the remaining two thirds of said estate divide into three equal parts allotting one equal third to Julia Ann, the other two thirds to Arthur and George infant heirs left by Arthur Middleton dec^d and the said Julia Ann having departed this life divided her portion of personal estate into three equal parts and allotting one equal third to Joseph T. Liles in right of his wife Sarah and the other two thirds to Arthur and George. We also allot to Sarah Liles one third part as dower of slaves, viz: Pinks Mary Lucy Fanny David & Joseph. We also allot to Arthur and George heirs of s^d decedent viz: Charles, James, Jacob, Billy & Igdon. We also allot one third part to Julia Ann third of slaves to Joseph T. Liles in right of his wife Sarah, viz: Matilda, and the other two thirds to Arthur & George infant heirs left by Arthur Middleton dec^d. viz: Thomas, Anthony & Oscar. We also allot to Sarah Liles one third part of real estate, line commencing at the Centre of her small black gum, red oak & water oak a new corner marked in James Jacksons line in the north edge of buckhorn swamp, thence N 42 1/4 E 420 poles to the run of the first swamp a corner in Edwin Harris line 381 acres for s^d dower the remaining two thirds for s^d Arthur & George heirs of s^d decedent. Given under our hands this 15th day of January 1842 Henry Kendrick, Edward Braton, James Jackson."
