

Thomas H. Dudley is appointed manager of the road from the Grand water at James H. Venghards to Brothers road in the town of Seal Prospect district and it is ordered that the usual bonds should be given.

On the motion Edwards Watts setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security for Safe Drawing for his due and faithful administration of the estate of William White dec^d and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by execution thereof and praying the Court for relief. Ordered that the said Safe Drawing be summoned to the first day of the next term to show cause why he should not be ruled to give the said Watts good consider security or to execute a new bond with security as the law directs.

Ordered that Sathlow R. Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, State settle and adjust an account of Safe Drawings administration of William White's estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Elias Barnes H^c against William Holt, Thomas H. Wade and Mills Devo. This day came the plaintiffs by their attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendants William Holt and Mills Devo have had legal notice of the motion they were solemnly called, but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiffs recover against the defendants Holt and Devo for four 7¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest thereon from the 5th day of August 1839 till paid, for seven 24¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest from the 11th of June 1839 till paid, for eight dollars with interest from the 12th of June 1839 till paid, for thirteen 1¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest from the 9th of May 1838 till paid, for fourteen 25¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest from 13th June 1839 till paid, for five dollars with interest from 19th March 1839 till paid, for seven 1¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest from September 15th 1839 till paid, for five 29¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest from 12th February 1839 till paid, for three 25¹/₁₀₀ dollars with interest from June 15th 1839 till paid, for eight 20¹/₁₀₀ dollars, for one 25¹/₁₀₀ dollars, for six dollars with interest from 27th April 1839 till paid, for one 25¹/₁₀₀ with interest from the 20th March 1839 till paid, for twelve 25¹/₁₀₀ with interest from 25th March 1839 till paid and for the sum of fifteen dollars with interest from the 22nd day of March 1839 till paid and these costs by them due & their motion in that behalf responded. And it the said defendants in Money &c.

Edward Edwards nephew of James H. Edwards dec^d with the approbation of the Court made choice of Anthony Venghards for his guardian and thereupon the said Anthony Venghards with Barnum Holt and Thomas Venghards his premises returned into and acknowledged at bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs.
