

For James Bell the wife was Samuel Lundy. William R. Stephenson having a majority of the votes was declared elected. the Court being of opinion that the said Stephenson is a man of honest property and good demeanor. Whereupon the said Stephenson took the oaths required by law and with John Vick and William Stephenson his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded.

A Deed of bargain and sale from John Hargrave to Sally Thomas was acknowledged by the said Hargrave and ordered to be recorded.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor and Haywood Owens daughter of Charles Owens pay unto to Miles Vick according to law covenanted with the said Miles Vick that he pay to the said Charles Owens twelve dollars per year during the apprenticeship, except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

The Registers of John Bailey, Ellis Bailey, James P. Hunt, James Williams, Matthew A. Turner and Nathaniel Andie fore sworn, were examined & certified to be truly made.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of the lower South bridge this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded. And is in these words to wit: Pursuant to an order of the County Court of Southamptford bearing date Decr Court 1841. We the undersigned did at the day of 1842 let the repairs of the lower South bridge where John Andie became the Court undertaker of the same for the sum of four hundred dollars. A Deed of bargain and sale from Corbett A. Carr, Arthur B. Hager & wife & Mary J. Battle to William Baymont was proved by the oath of Alexander Myrick and David Baymont two of the witnesses thereto.

Ordered that the presentment of the grand jury made this day against Charles Ferguson be certified to a Justice of the Peace for the County.
