For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Person of the Poor land Margaret Evans daughter of Charlotte Evans payees to Willis Vick according to law. Commencing with the said Willis Vick that he pay to the said Charlotte Evans twelve dollars per year during the apprenticeship, except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

The Registers of John Bailey, Eliza Bailey, James P. Blunt, James Williams, Martha A. Turner and Nathan Antis pro negro, were examined & certified to be duly made.

The Commissioners appointed to take the repairs of the lower South Bridge this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded. And as in these words to wit: Pursuant to an order of the County Court of Southampton bearing date Decr Court 1841. We the undersigned dated the day of 1842 set the repairs of the lower South Bridge when John Edger became the Court undertaker of the same for the sum of fourteen dollars. A Deed of Bargain and Sale from Ernest A. Cox, Arthur Battagel & wife Mary J. Nettle to William Bryant was passed by the hands of Alexander Myrick and David Bryant two of the witnesses thereto.

Ordered that the presentment of the grand jury made this day against Charles Ingerson be certified to a Justice of the Peace for the County.
