The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report in these words towt.
In conformity to the aforesaid decree, we the undersigned Commissioners who are appointed by
the County Court of Southampton to sell the tract of land that Policy Turner died seized and
possessed of, have after advertising the same as we were directed sold to the highest bidder
on the forenoon the 9th day of April 1822 the tract of land mentioned in the Bill
containing 25 acres and William Harris became the purchaser for the sum of twenty five
the decree directs the expenses to be paid in cash, which are as follows. Lawyer fee eight
dollars, Clerks fee \$2.50 and the Commission One dollar and 25 Cents, making in the
aggregate of \$1.65. This sum taken from \$25.00 the amount sales leaves \$24.35 etc
This last sum is divided into three equal parts making the sum of four dollars 79 cents
each my part and we have taken three bonds from William Harris & Benj. Griffin his
security for the sum of \$4.79 cents and have paid them over to the distributees as aforesaid
in the decree, say one to Cle Davis, one to Bennett Griffin and the other one to William Harris

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of the bridge across Mapenburg mill

proceeded to advertise and did on the 20th of last November let at public auction to the lowest
undertaker the repairs of the bridge across Mapenburg Mill race all of which was to be new
except the brick piers and any sound timber still standing where Wells Murfee and
William Peale became the undertakers for two hundred and forty nine dollars Given under my
hand this 18th of April 1822. J H Murfee Com"

Wm V Edwards have viewed and examined the repairs of the above named bridge and find
that the work has been done according to the Contract. We hope that the above amount and
(\$249 Dollars will be exact. Given under our hands this 18th day of April 1822.
