On the motion of James Drake for leave to alter a road &c For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the name of Patrick Rowe be substituted for the name of James Rowe in the order made at the last term. After upon the Commissioners this day made report which is in these words, "agreeable to the above order of Court the Elijah J. Jeyner and Patrick Rowe being sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose, have raised the road and assured that it will be no inconvenience to the Public and advantage to James Drake the applicant this 20th day of April 1842.
