On the motion of James Drake for leave to alter a road go. For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the name of Patrick Rowe be substituted for the name of John Rowe in the order made at the last Term. Whereupon the Commissioner this day made report which is in these words, "Agreeable to the above order of Court Mr. Elijah Jaynor and Patrick Rowe being sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose, have viewed the road and we find that it will be more inconvenient to the publick and advantage to James Drake the applyer this 20th day of April 1842.
