The order made at the last term directing the Sheriff of this County to summon
the Justices to this Court to receive or reject the provisions of law passed "March 5th 1858
entitl'd "An Act to provide for the opening and repairing of the public roads in the

reduce into one the several acts concerning public roads and for establishing
public landings" passed February the 25th 1857.
