The Account Current and Commissioners report of Joseph J Claude administration on Robert J Musgrave's estate was returned and ordered to be on file for inspection.

The Request of Eliza Davis, John Powell Alfred Diggs & Hannah Buck per se were examined and certified to be truly made.

The order made at the last term directing the Sheriff of the County to summon the judges to this Court to receive or reject the provisions of law passed "March 5th 1815" entitled "An Act to provide for the opening and repairing of the public roads in the Commonwealth" being afterwards corrected. The Court upon consideration did reject the act above referred to, and retain the provisions of the act entitled "An Act to reduce into one the several acts concerning public roads and for establishing public landings passed February the 22nd 1817."
