Person James Jackson & John Whetstone or any three of them being first sworn according to Law do on the 25th Inst and after the damages to the land belonging to the heirs of William S. Smith show for which the Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road passes lying on the north side of the Meherrin river and bounded by the lands of John Edwards Nathaniel Jones John D. Turner and others and make report thereof to Court.
