

Newt Duce foreman, Richard H. Draman, Joseph O. Mardouagh, S. Edman, John Mount, J. Davis, Erwin Vaughan, Alfred T. Stephenson, Abington Gardner, William H. Mason, Robert Griffin, Jesse Barnett, Erman Bryant, William Harrison, Barton Taylor, John Williams, John C. Turner, Hartwell Cole, Thomas A. West, both Perry & Baines were sworn a grand jury of fifteen upon the body of this County and having received their charge with delay and after some time returned and presented George H. Sping of Southampton County for forging the name of Richard A. Vezahant from the evidence of Richard A. Vezahant sworn out of Court to the grand Jury. We present Edward P. Turner for shooting and drawing a pistol on street Duce in the high way in the County of Southampton on the 3 Monday of February 1842 upon the evidence of William A. Jones and Joseph T. Chaud sent for by the grand jury and sworn in Court to give evidence. And having nothing further to present were discharged.

Ordered that the presentment this day made by the grand Jury against George H. Sping be certified to a justice of the peace for this County to be proceeded in according to Law.

Ordered that Edward P. Turner be summoned to August Court next to show cause why an Information should not be filed against him upon the presentment of the grand Jury this day made against him.

On the motion of Albert Croft ordered that the license granted him to sell merchandise as a merchant at Ochlockville be transferred to Franklin.

On the motion of Newt Duce and William Baines setting forth that they are bound in this Court as security for David Newsum for his due and faithful administration of the Estate of Martha Newsum dec'd and they conceiving themselves in danger of suffering by occasion thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is Ordered that the said David Newsum be summoned to the next Term of this Court and give the said Duce and Baines good counter security according to Law.

On motion of James C. Clapham, Ordered that Richard A. Vezahant, Benjamin Griffin and Thugars Sam being first sworn before a justice of the peace for that purpose. View the way proposed for turning a new road leading from Suckers Swamp meeting house to some point on the road leading from Jerusalem to Smithfield and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Patrick Dole, Ordered that the Estate of Benjamin Hales dec'd be committed to the hands of William L. Conwell Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

Ordered that H. S. Smith, Seth D. Williams and Jesse Porter or any two of them with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Atandamand, let to the land
