Ordered that the presentment this day made by the Grand Jury against George
 H. Spiry be certified to a Justice of the Peace for this County to be presented in ac-
 cording to Law.

Ordered that Edward P. Turner be summoned to August Court next to show
 cause why an information should not be filed against him upon the presentment
 of the Grand Jury this day made against him.

On the Motion of Albert Dref ordered that the license granted him to sell mer-
 chandise &c as a merchant at Rockville be transferred to Franklin.

On the Motion of Nevil Drew and William Prince setting forth that they are
 bound in this Court as security for David Neuron for his due and faithful admin-
 istration of the Estate of Martha Neuron dec'd and they conceiving themselves in danger
 of suffering by occasion thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is Ordered that
 the said David Neuron be summoned to the next Term of this Court and give
 the said Drew and Prince good Counter security according to Law.

On motion of James C. Clapp. Ordered that Richard A. Urquhart Benjamin
 Griffin and Thurgas Lain being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that
 purpose view the way proposed for opening a new road leading from Suckers
 Swamp meeting house to some point on the road leading from Somersham to Smithfield
 and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Patrick Cole. Ordered that the Estate of Benjamin Hester dec'd
 be committed to the hands of William L. Everett Sheriff of this County for administration
 according to Law.

Ordered that H. P. Smith. Seth D. Williams and Jno Parker or any two of them
 with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Nansemond. Let to the last
