

John M Gurley and Samuel Wells Commissioners of the Revenue severally rendered on oath a list of their taxable property, and complied with the law concerning ordinary taxes. Merchants &c

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Broad Water Bridge across Black Hala River this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded, and in the following words to wit.

"The County of Solth of eight Northampton. In account with Richd A Vezubart. To repair of Broad water Bridge in year 1841. $\$161.00$ a 851 feet of timber furnished @ $\$3$ per c 25.53 = $\$186.53$ Lr By 2000 feet of old timber @ $\$0.9$ per foot 5.50 $\$181.03$ Pursuant to an order of the County Court of Solth of eight bearing date June Court 1841 we the undersigned Commissioners in conjunction with commissioners appointed by the County of Southampton County have let out the repairs of Broad water Bridge to Richard A Vezubart and William B Vezubart, of Southampton County for the sum of One hundred and sixty one dollars, and we the undersigned agreed to pay Richard A Vezubart for all timber subject to the contract. Three dollars per hundred for which Richard A Vezubart furnished 851 feet more than what we agreed it would take, we contracted that the said Richard A Vezubart should furnish good heart timber where ever he might find any rotten and be allowed three dollars per foot for all that he might furnish, and the said Bridge to be done agreeable to contract over before the 30th day of November next. Given under our hands this 1st day of April 1842. The Bridge has since received by the Commissioners. Henry H Wemble. A. B. Vezubart. Jno Doughton"
