The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Broad Water Bridge a crop Black  
Male Tarr this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded, and so in the fol-  
lowing words to wit.

The County of Isle of Wight Southampton. In account with Richd A Urquhart.  
To repair of Broad water Bridge in year 1841 £161.00 + 85.1 foot of timber furnished  
@ 3/- per ft 25.53 = £186.53 L5 By 2000 foot of old timber @ 9/- per foot £80.00 £186.53  
Pursuant to an order of the County Court of Isle of Wight坐着 late June Court  
1841 we the undersigned Commissioners in conjunction with commissioners appointed  
by the County of Southampton County have let out the repairs of Broad water Bridge  
to Richard A Urquhart and Asylum R Urquhart, of Southampton County for  
the sum of one hundred and fifty one dollars, and we the undersigned agreed to  
pay Richard A Urquhart for all timber subject to the contract three dollars  
per hundred for which Richard A Urquhart furnished 857 foot more than  
what we agreed it would take, we contracted that the said Richard A Urquhart  
should furnish good heart timber where ever he might find any rotten and be  
allowed three dollars per foot for all that he might furnish, and the said Bridge  
to be done agreeable to contract over before the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November next  
Given under our hands the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1842. The Bridge has been received  
by the Commissioners Henry A Womble A.C. Urquhart. Jno Boykin"

On the Motion of Francis D. Butts Ordered that Master Commissioner Colb examine State  
and settle an account of the said Butts Guardianship of Mary Doniger and make  
report thereof to Court.

On the Motion of John M. Gurley. Ordered that Littleton R Edwards who is  
hence appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose State settle and adjust an  
account of the said Gurley transactions as Executor of John H Barnes d.<sup>r</sup> and make  
report thereof to Court.
