Whereupon the said deed together with the certificate annexed of the jury examination and a check called grant of the wife is ordered to be recorded.

This day came the plaintiff by his Attorney And the defendant still failing to appear and James Clayton the garnishee appeared and being sworn declared that he was indebted to the Defendant in the sum of fifteen dollars and more. Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the sum of ten dollars with interest from the 1st day of October 1834 till paid with costs and it is ordered that the said Clayton pay to the plaintiff the sum of fifteen dollars admitted to be in his hands in part payment of this judgment.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of Black Creek Bridge this day made their report which report is in the following words to wit: "Appeable to an order of Southampton County Court, to us directed, bearing date February Court 1842: we the undersigned after having given legal notice by advertisement, proceeded on the 22nd day of March 1842 to let the repairs of Black Creek bridge to the lowest undertaker as by the order we were required, and Allen Edwards became the undertaker of the same for the sum of One hundred and twenty six dollars and fifty cents which repairs were completed on the 15th day of June 1842 at which time we proceeded to the reception of the same, and upon strict examination found the said Bridge in complete order." Given under our hands this 15th day of June 1842 Joseph H Johnson Thos J Porter."

John P. Doylin who stands charged on oath by Matilda Joyner with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court and for want of appearing to the Court this case is continued till the next Term.
