

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of the three Creek Bridges this day made their report. which report is in the following words to wit: "Pursuant to the annexed order we have proceeded to let the repairs of said Bridges to the lowest undertaker, and it was undertaken by Thomas B. Williamson for the sum of sixty four dollars and seventy five cents. The timber has all been got brought to the place named, and on Wednesday last said Williamson commenced raising the same but owing to the frost has failed to complete it as yet the old Bridge is down and part of the new raised, all of which will be completed in two weeks which we feel willing to guarantee and as he shows so hard to complete it by to day but was prevented by the frost, and promised to do it as soon as the water falls, we think the day ought to be made, all of which is respectfully submitted." The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of the little Swamp bridges this day made their report. this report is in the words following to wit: "Due obedience to an order made February last authorizing us the undersigned Commissioners to let to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of little swamp bridges, we did on the 18th of April let said bridge for the performance of which work John R. Briggs became the contractor for the sum of three hundred dollars. And in further compliance with said order, we did on the 18th day of June meet to examine said bridge, which is put up agreeable to contract." R. H. Patten, Ransom S. Harwell."
