

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairing of the Chee Creek Bridges this day made their report which report is in the following words to wit " Pursuant to the aforesaid order we have proceeded to let the repairing of said Bridges to the lowest undertaker, and it was undertaken by Thomas B Williamson for the sum of forty four dollars and seventy five cents. The timber has all been got brought to the place named and on wednesday last said Williamson commenced raising the same but owing aforesaid has failed to complete it as yet the old Bridge is down and part of the new raised all of which will be completed in two weeks which we feel willing to guarantee and as he stood so hard to complete it by to day but was prevented by the frost, and promised to do it as soon as the water falls we think the day ought to be made, all of which a respectfully submitted " E B Coland J St Turner Comr."

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairing of the little Swamp bridge this day made their report which report is in the words following to wit " By Orderance to an act made February last authorising us the undersigned Commissioners to let to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of little swamp bridge, we did on the 18<sup>th</sup> of April let said bid for the performance of which work John R Briggs became the contractor for the sum of three hundred dollars. And on further compliance with said order, we did on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June meet to examine said bridge, which is put up agreeable to contract" Ross Patten, Ransom G Harwell"

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb et amicis State and Dille an account of Samuel Calverts administration on Martha Millehairs Estate and make report thereof to Court with any matter specially stated or deemed pertinent by him which may be required to State.

Mary and John Patten orphans of Joseph Patten deceased with the approbation of the Court made choice of Alfred Riols for their Guardian whereupon the said Riols with John Vick, John Bankford, Benjamin Roxany and Clement Rockhill be sequestered and acknowledged a bond in the sum of thirty thousand dollar conditioned as the law directs.

The Court doth appoint Robert S Patten guardian to Elizabeth Patten and thereupon the said R S Patten with Robert Riols, Thomas Pullen and William Job his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of fifteen thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Frederick Tazgant is appointed surveyor of the road from the foot of the bridge at Dennislow to Dennisons Head in the room of Benjamin Ladd deceased and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made theron.
