Deed of trust between Isaac Andrew of the first part William H. Mason of the second part and Howell A. Atkins of the third part conveying one slave was acknowledged in the Office on the 20th day of June 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edwin Daughtry and wife to Anthony Daughtry conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 20th day of June 1842 by Edwin Daughtry and together with the certificate of the magistrates and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Ascut Brew and wife to James Dwyer conveying land was returned to the Office on the 20th day June 1842 and together with the certificate thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Jeremiah Stephens of the first part John M. Gurley of the second part and Nathan Wood of the third part conveying personal property was proved in the Office on the 20th June 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

This Indenture of marriage agreement between Willis Mellons and Eliza Seab was proved in the Office on 20th June 1842 by all the parties thereto & committed to Record.

Deed of trust between Lawrence D. Daughtry of the first part Cassin Harrison of the second part and Thos. Seagren of the third part conveying land of personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 20th June 1842 by Daughtry & Seagren two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from L.R. Edwards and Anthony W. Williams to Geo. A. H. Newson conveying land &c was acknowledged in the Office on 30th June 1842 by Edwards one of the parties thereto and together with the certificate of the acknowledgment of William Spring examination of the wife admitted to Record.
