Smith Edward Campbell & Jesse Parker being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose trace the way proposed for widening the said road as well as the present way and report to the Court the comparative convenience and inconvenience that will result as well as individuals as to the public of the alteration be made as proposed.

Francis P. Butler is appointed surveyor of the road in the name of William Edward Esq. and it is ordered that the usual bonds do with them.

On the motion of Robert Barnes Ordered that Morist S. Whitney Esq. of Justice Whitney Esq. render an account of his administration before Master Commissioner Court and that the said Court examine State & settle the same and make report thereof to Court with any matter specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On the motion of James B. Massey Esq. curator of the persons of Solated Johnson Esq. Ordered that the Clerk of the Court deliver to the said Massey being the four several bonds filed in his Office in the Chancery suit for the debt of the said Solated Johnson Esq.
