Deed of bargain and sale from John Moore jr and Delia his wife to George H. Gardner conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1842 by John Moore and together with the certificate of the proper examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Childred Akumde of the first part, Sampson C. Aune of the second part and Joseph T. Holland of the third part conveying to the said Akumde one of all kinds was acknowledged in the Office on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Robert R. Collier Commissioner of the said John A. Towner conveying land was returned to the Clerk's Office on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1842. Together with the certificate thereto annexed admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William D. Nord of the first part, Lilliaton R. Edwards of the second part and Edwards Watts of the third part conveying negro slaves was acknowledged in the Office on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1842 by Nord & Edwards two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Thomas R. Sims of the first part, Lilliaton R. Edwards of the second part and William J. Ford & N. M. Sebell of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> July 1842 by Jones Edwards & N. M. Sebell three of the parties and having been before acknowledged in the said Office on the 20<sup>th</sup> June 1842 by Wm. Sebell the other party thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust from John C. Turner to William R. Sparks conveying all the said Turner estate both real and personal was acknowledged in the Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> July 1842 by the said Turner & Sparks and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin H. Griffin of the first part, Patrick Dolan of the second part and John Fulgham of the third part conveying personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 21<sup>st</sup> July 1842 by Griffin & Fulgham two of the parties and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin Cobb of the first part, Augustus H. Hart of the second part and Grantly Williams of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin H. Barham of the first part, James McLeman of the second part and Atahau B. Brown of the third part conveying to the said Barham one of all kinds and personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1842 by all the parties and admitted to Record.
