Deed of bargain and sale from John Moore Jr and wife Delia his wife to George H. Gardner conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 18th day of July 1842 by John Moore and together with the certificate of the survey isamination postmark and account of the survey admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Obediah Marshall of the first part Sampson C. Rose of the second part and Joseph T. Claude of the third part conveying to the said Marshall except all birds was acknowledged in the Office on the 18th day of July 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Robert R. Collier Commissioner to John C. Person conveying land was returned to the Clerks Office on the 18th day of July 1842. Together with the certificate thereto annexed admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William H. Stark of the first part Littleton A. Edwards of the second part and Edwards Battle of the third part conveying negro slaves was acknowledged in the office on the 18th day of July 1842 by Stark & Edwards two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Thomas C. Sims of the first part Littleton A. Edwards of the second part and William A. and A. M. Schell of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 19th July 1842 by Jones Edwards & A. M. Schell three of the parties and having been before acknowledged in the said Office on the 20th June 1842 by Wm. Schell the other party thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust from John C. Turner to William A. Spark conveying all the said Turners estate both real and personal was acknowledged in the office on the 19th July 1842 by the said Turner & Spark and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin H. Griffin of the first part Patrick Dole of the second part and John Fulgham of the third part Conveying personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 21st July 1842 by Griffin & Fulgham two of the parties and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin Cobb of the first part Augustus H. Hart of the second part and Grantly Williams of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Office on the 2nd day of August 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Benjamin H. Hoban of the first part James McLean of the second part and at about 13 acres of the third part conveying his the said 13 acres and personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 5th day of August 1842 by all the parties and admitted to Record.
