Lillieton R. Edwards and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Samuel A. Stone of the first part Lillieton R. Edwards  
and Thomas J. Gholson of the second part and Martha and John W. Rockwell  
and others of the third part conveying land negro and all his the said Hens  
Estate of every kind and description was acknowledged at the Clerks Office on the  
12<sup>th</sup> day of August 1842 by Stone and Edwards two of the parties thereto and admitted  
to Record.

Deed of trust between Mills & Lawrence of the first part William H. Wright of the  
second part and John H. Lawrence of the third part conveying land and in the said  
Mills & Lawrence interest in certain slaves was found in the Office on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of  
August 1842 by them of the subscribing witnesses Slaves & admitted to Record.
