

according to the subpoenaed order to show the ground way &c for removing the Road leading from Jerusalem to South Quay on Capt Senor Mansur's land and the report the convenience & inconvenience both to the Publick & individuals. His Honor to state that we have been by your body herebefore appointed for the purpose & reported according to our belief & judgment. we considered the change advisable and stated the comparative or relative advantage and disadvantages both to the publick and individuals. we have again hereover reviewed the condition and situation of the old Road (and ground on which the new Road is now located (and put in good repair & condition by Capt Mansur) & further state that it is in good order when at the same time the old Road is quite to the contrary. we also have a correct survey which we herewith submit (as the distance set forth in our former report by the revolution of a wheel & not exactly correct) showing the present loss & gain to travellers in all direction & fully believe (to say nothing of the very great convenience and saving of distance to those travelling from the direction of South Quay to Franklin's Point as we believe & before stated that more than double the trouble was from that direction which opinion we get entertaining that the little increase of distance occasioned by the change in going from Jerusalem to South Quay will be fully or more than balanced in the prospect of shortening of the new Road

Whereupon it is ordered that the said Road as opened be raised & established as a public highway

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the present of the road leading from South Quay to the Cedar Swamp do stop at the end of the new road joining the Franklin road and that the surveyor of the road leading from Franklin to Jerusalem do work to the run of the Cedar Swamp.
