Be it remembered that Lucy Cobb, William Cobb & Benjamin Cobb here in Court severally acknowledge themselves indebted unto John M Gayory, Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Lucy Cobb in the sum of fifty dollars and the said Benjamin Cobb & William Cobb in the sum of \$25, each of their respective goods & chattels lands & tenements to be levied and to the said Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor and his successor in the office of Governor for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Lucy Cobb shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the term of twelve months from this day then this recognizance shall be void.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning nine o'clock.
