

On the motion of Carr Powers. Ordered that Littleton A. Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do settle and adjust an additional account of the said Powers administration on Thomas Gray estate and make report thereof to Court.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repairs of the Creek Bridge near Benjamin Williamson this day made their report which report is on the record and figures to wit: Pursuant to an order from the County Court of Loudoun County to as directed we proceeded to let the repairs of the Creek Bridge near Benjamin Williamson and the same was undertaken by Thomas B. Williamson for the sum sixty four dollars & 10<sup>cts</sup>. but owing to the constant freshets he was unable to complete the same by our given Court thereupon the Court ordered the money laid out to remain in the Sheriff's hands until the work was completed, whereupon which time the work has been completed by said Thomas B. Williamson, and as we considered, according to contract therefore we have received the same, all of which is respectfully submitted. 15<sup>th</sup> September 1832. "Edw. C. Cland Thos. J. On the motion of Jesse S. Bailey and Thomas J. Drumright. Ordered that Master Commissioner Bridges examine state and settle an account of the said Bailey or Drumright administration on Puffin Arab estate and make report thereof to Court.

On motion of Harrison W. Moore guardian to Jonathan Byrants of hand. Ordered that Harrison Soper Leake (Murdough and James W. Musgrave) one of them do appraise and set apart to Cherry Byrants the widow of Jonathan Byrants one third in value of the lands of the said Jonathan Byrants to be held for life to and for her sever heirs.
