It is ordered that the said David Newson give the said Drew & Prince good Counter Security the land for which purpose is to be in the possestion of the land executed by the said David Newson as administrator as of record, and conditioned according to law. And the said David Newson failing to give the said land of security it is ordered that the powers & duties of the said David Newson as administrator as aforesaid be voided and annulled.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Officers of the Poor buid Ben Seaborn an ophage free negro to Samuel P. James according to Law that the said James pay annually to the Poor the sum of ten dollars during the apprenticeship of the said of the said Ben Seaborn except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

Ordered that the Justices of this County be summoned to the first day of October term next to elect a Clerk of this Court to supply the vacancy soon to be created by the expiration of the term of the present Clerk.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon the Justices of this County to the next term of this Court to consider the application of James B. Neighard for leave to erect gates along a public highway

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the Justices of this County to October term next to recommend other persons to be appointed Commissioners Justices of this County
