Ordered that the Sheriff pay to Thomas B. Williamson the sum owed for him at June Term last for repairs to the Creek bridge.

On motion of Asa W. Drew & William Prince against David Newsum owner Martha Newsum de^d for Counter Security. The summons awarded at the last term being returned executed and the Defendant Newsum not appearing. It is ordered that the said David Newsum give the said Drew & Prince good Counter Security the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of the bond executed by the said David Newsum as administrator as aforesaid, and conditioned according to Law and the said David Newsum failing to give the said bond & security it is ordered that the power & duties of the said David Newsum as administrator as aforesaid be null and annulled.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Orphans of the Poor bond Ben Seaborn an orphan free negro to Samuel P. James according to Law that the said James pay annually to the Poor the sum of ten dollars during the apprenticeship of the said of the said Ben Seaborn except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

Ordered that the Justices of this County be summoned to the first day of October term next to elect a clerk of this Court to supply the vacancy soon to be created by the expiration of the term of the present clerk.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon the Justices of this County to the next term of this Court to consider the application of James B. Hughes for leave to erect gates across a public highway.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the Justices of this County to October term next to recommend other persons to be appointed Non-judicial Justices of this County.
