This day this cause was docketed by law of Court and consent of parties and came on to be heard on the bill and answer and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order adjudge and decree that John Troy twelve to the marriage articles executed to him by Timothy Warkham and wife, be amerced as follows and that Joseph S. Caudle be appointed in his place with full power to act in like manner.

The Commissioners appointed to apportion Dower to Cherry Bryant and the widow of Jonathan Bryant, this day made their report, which report is in the words following to wit,

"Agreeably to the aforesaid order, we the Commissioners have ascertained and set a part, to the best of our ability, without a survey, to Mrs Cherry Bryant one third in value of the land of Jonathan Bryant & his wife as comprising the portion held by her which was the dower of Lewis Jaynes widow. The boundaries of Mrs C Bryant's land are as follows. Beginning at the corner of the dower of the said Lewis Jaynes widow, thence a straight line between Mrs C Bryant and third and the orphans of John Bryant deeded to a person in town near the dwelling thence a new line of marked trees as far as a Hickory tree below the hill, thence a new line of marked trees as far as to a small oak bush at the corner of Mr Isidor Bryant's fence, a corner between Mr C Bryant and third and the said orphans of above Bryant & thence along the old line of marked trees between this tract and the said Isidor Bryant to Mr Harrison Jaynes line. thence along the old line between this tract and the said H. Jaynes to another corner of the parcel allotted to the widow of Lewis Jaynes, thence along the line between this tract and the dower of Lewis Jaynes as far as to the beginning. And we further allow Mrs Cherry Bryant to move on her said tract small log house in front of the dwelling. All of which is respectfully submitted
