This day the cause was docketed, by leave of the Court and consent of parties and came on to be heard on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order adjudge and decree, that Silas and Myrick Calist Corvill and Jacob Barwell be appointed Commissioners, any two of whom may act, that they after advertising the time and place of sale forthwith day sell at public auction to the highest bidder, the lands whereof Elizabeth Stephenson died seized, upon a credit of nine months, (except for so much as may be necessary to pay the costs of this decree which they are required to receive in cash) that they take one bond for one half the amount of sale and assign the same to William & Stephenson in his own right - for the other half of the amount sales they take one bond one for one sixth part of one half and assign the same to Polly Stephenson widow of Henry Stephenson in lieu of her dower, and that they subdivide the balance of said one half into four equal parts taking bonds for the same which they are to assign severally to Rebecca Ann and James St Stephenson infant children of Henry Stephenson and then deposit the same in the Clerk's Office subject to the order of the parties by their guardians or themselves when they arrive at lawful age and report to the Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Thomas Hume Jr. Benjamin Little and Henry Gelling or any two of them do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge near John Henry Blaw Hall and report the same to Court.

Ordered that James W. Barber Thomas Reilly Henry B. Vaughan and Lewis Mordell or any three of them, after being first duly sworn for that purpose do truly & justly appraise the estate of Bailey Raymond *de* and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that Samuel Holmes Joshua Pappan John F. Le attorney of Henry Holland or any three of them after being first duly sworn for that purpose do appraise the estate of George W. Holland *de* and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court.

Ordered that John B. Jenkins John B. Williams and Gordon Edwards or any two of them do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bull Bridge near Franklin Depot within the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

The Court doth assign Martha Bapett Guardian to Martha Margaret Bapett Oris Bapett orphans of James Bapett *de*. Thereupon she together with John Scarborough Jr and John Scarborough Jr. her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars and then directed
