This day this cause was docketed by leave of the Court and consent of parties and
came on to be heard on the bill and answer, and was argued by Counsel. On
consideration whereof the Court doth order adjudge and decree that Alexander Myrick
Walt Orrill and Jacob Barrell be appointed commissaries, any two of whom may
act, that they after advertising the time and place of sale for twenty days sell all
public auction to the highest bidder, the lands whereof Elizabeth Stephenson died
died, upon a credit of nine months, (except for so much as may be necessary
to pay the costs of this decree which they are required to receive in cash) that they
take one bond for one half the amount of sale and assign the same to William G
Stephenson in his own right - for the other half of the amount sales they take from bond
one for one sixth part of one half and assign the same to Polly Stephenson widow of
Henry Stephenson in law of her donee, and that they subdivide the balance of said
one half into three equal parts taking bonds for the same which they are to assign
severally to Rebecca Ann and James W Stephenson infant children of Henry
Stephenson and then deposit the same in the Clerk's Office subject to the order of
the parties by their guardians or themselves when they attain at lawful age and
report to the Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Thomas Moore Jr Churchills wife and Henry Bellamy or any two of them
let to the lowest undertaker the repair of the bridge near Coln George Below Mill and
report the same to Court.

Ordered that James W Parker Thomas Reilly Henry D Vaughan and Lewis Ward
or any two of them, after being first duly sworn for that purpose do truly & fairly
appraise the estate of Bailey Bryant deceased and return the appraisement under
their hands to Court.

Ordered that Samuel Holmes Joshua Phipps John T Geatley & Henry Holland
or any two of them after being first duly sworn for that purpose do appraise the
estate of George W Holland deceased and return the appraisement under their hands
to the Court.

Ordered that John R Jenkins John S Williams and Gordon Edwards among two of
them do let to the lowest undertaker the repair of the Small Bridge near Franklin
Dept within the same when completed and make report thereof to the Court.

The Court doth adjudge Martha Bapell Guardian to Martha Margaret D
Orrie Bapell wife of James Bapell deceased then to be together with John
Trotter Jr and John Trotter Jr his son to be divided into two shares
one half in the pecuniary of the hundred dollars and the other share
