This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties with the assent of the Court and came on to be heard on the bill, answer, exhibits, and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that the plaintiff Mary Richardson by her deed, duly acknowledged under proper examination before the magistrates, relinquish her right of dower in the tract of land sold & conveyed by her husband, John T. Richardson to Alexander B. Bate and Charlotte Nicholas as in the exhibit set forth, and that the same none the less be valid & effectual as if she had been a party to the said deed, & duly relinquished her dower in the same. That John B. Chambliss her next friend, receive the sum of two hundred dollars the consideration for the said relinquishment and invest it by buying up the interest in remainder of the slaves which Eliza Richardson bequeathed to her mother her life with remainder to Thomas A. Richardson if in his judgment the same can be bought at a reasonable price and that he as her next friend & her successor as such hold the said negroes in fee simple, as the separate estate of the said Mary Richardson free from the claim or control of her said husband, or any person claiming under him and that the said Chambliss report his proceedings to this Court in order to a final decree.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Richard Mack dec'd. and returned, examined & ordered to be the order.

On the motion of William Davis for the use and benefit of James Houghton against James Bell and William R. Ford. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore the said motion is continued till the next Term.

John T. Hines who is in custody of the Sheriff of this County upon a "Ca sa" in favor of Sittlen Davis who was for the use of James Vick, appeared in Court and throughly substantiated and delivered in his schedule and took the oath for the relief of insolvent debtors, whereupon it is ordered that he be discharged of all taken for no other reason.
