This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties with the assent of the Court, and came on to be heard on the bill, answer, exhibits, and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court did adjudge, order and decree, that the plaintiff Mary Richardson by her deed, duly acknowledged under pains examination before two magistrates, relinquished her right of Rower in the tract of land sold & conveyed by her husband John T. Richardson to Alexander P. Betts and Charlotte Nickerson as in the exhibit set forth, and that the same now notwithstanding as valid & effectual as she had been a party to the said deed, & duly relinquished her dower in the same. That John P. Chamberly her next friend, receive the sum of three hundred dollars the consideration for the said relinquishment and instead of by laying up the intent to remainder of the slaves which Eliza Richardson bequeathed to her mother her wife with remainder to Thomas A. Richardson if in his judgement the same can be bought at a reasonable price, and that he as her next friend & successor as such holdeth said negroes in fee simple, as the separate estate of the said Mary Richardson free from the claims or control of her said husband, or any person claiming under him and that the said Chamberly report his proceedings to this Court in order to a final decree.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of Richard Hart deceased, and returned, examined & ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of William Davis for the use and benefit of James Blaylock against James Bell and William P. Hord. This day came the plaintiff by his Attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of this motion, they were solemnly called to come into Court. Thereupon the said Motion is continued till the next Term.

John P. Davis who is in custody of the Sheriff of this County before a "Carbo" in favor of Littleton Davis who sue for the use of James Vick, appeared in Court and thereupon subscriber and delivered in his schedule and took the oaths for the relief of Plaintiff debtors, whereupon it is ordered that he be discharged of obtained for me other cause.
