The Court doth further order & adjudge of record that A. Smith and Harrison Cobb be appointed Commissioners, and that they sell to the highest bidder upon a credit of six months, the negro Bill in which Mrs. Amanda Gatling held an interest and take one land for one half the amount and apportion the same to the Guardian of Harrison Parker, and for the other half take seven lands of equal amount and apportion the same as follows, one to the Guardian of Harrison Parker, one to James Gatling, one to Briggs Gatling, one to Adkins and Sarah his wife one to Joshua Fegerson and Catharine his wife, one to John Cotton & Nancy his wife & one James Beale & Elizabeth his wife, and the said Commissioners are instructed to make report to the Court in order to a final decree.
