The Court doth further order adjudged & decree that A. T. Smith and Harrison Cobb be appointed Commissioners, and that they sell to the highest bidder, upon a credit of six month, the negro Bill in which Mrs. Amanda Galling held an interest and take one bond for one half the amount and assign the same to the guardian of Garrison Parker, and for the other half take seven bonds of equal amounts and assign the same as follows, one to the guardian of Garrison Parker, one to James Galling, one to Bugg Galling, one to _____ Atkins and Sarah his wife one to Joshua Foggerson and Catharine his wife, one to John Cotton & Nancy his wife & one James Beale & Elizabeth his wife, and the said Commissioners are instructed to make report to the Court in order to a final decree.
