Ordered that Henry Pelkey, Benjamin Applebush, Parham Munson & Thomas Munn at the expense of Forts bridge across the three creeks, receive the same when completed & make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the overseers of the Poor bind Lydia Evans daughter of Jerry Evans free negro to River Barker according to Law, the said River Barker paying to the Master for the services of the said Lydia the sum of ten dollars annually from the time of her arrival at the age of twelve years to the age of eighteen years except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

John Taylor who is in custody of the Sheriff of this County at the suit of Samuel J. Douglas who sue for the benefit of John M. Bailey by virtue of an execution and that of this Court, was brought in to Court & thereupon he subscribed and delivered in a schedule of his estate & made oath thereof according to Law, whereupon it is ordered that he be discharged from Custody if detained for no other cause than the execution aforesaid.

It appearing to the Court that there are two negro boys to wit Artie enclosed in the jail of this County and that they are free and came to this County from the State of North Carolina, it is ordered that the Jailor do on December Court day next, having given due notice thereof, hire out the said negroes for such term as will pay their jail fees and other expenses, at the expiration of which time they are discharged.

Ordered that Lewis Harris, Alexander Briggs & David Brince or any two of them do raise the bridges lately built by Corvine B. Mayes, called Masons Mill Swamp bridges, and report to the Court what the building of said bridges are worth.

On the Motion of Anthony M. Howell who made oath and together with John R. Williams Harrison Joyner & Sipe Barker his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of David Howell dec'd in due form.

On the Motion of Edwards Bells, admor of James Bell dec'd. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court settle an account of the said James Bells administration on Brownly Bells Estate and report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated demanded justly by himself or which may be required to be so stated.
