Deed of bargain and sale from William Joyner and wife to James Williams
conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842
by William Joyner a party thereto and together with the Certificate of the jury exam-
ination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Mills L. Gray of the first part Thomas B. Knight of the
second part Jacob Williams Matthew R. Pope and Sampson Pope of the third part
conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842 by
Gray, Williams and Matthew R. Pope three of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Jeremiah Chappell of the first part Thomas J. Batten of the
second part and Thomas Batten of the third part conveying land and one half of a mill
