Deed of trust between Joshua Joyner and wife of the first part Sam Bowes of the second part and James Holmes of the third part conveying land was forced in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by the oaths William Turner & Ludlow Lawrence two of the trustees thereunto having been before present in the Office the 31st day of October 1842 by the oath of Benjamin Griffin another trustee thereunto was together with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Robert A. Holmes and wife to John H. Booth conveying land was returned in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 together with the certificate thereunto annexed admitted to Record.

M. Howell three of the trustees there unto W. Horrell a party thereto and was acknowledged by Henry Hendred another party thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Burns and wife to Jacob Weston conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by Benjamin Burns a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William Joyner and wife to James Williams conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by William Joyner a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Miles L Gray of the first part Thomas D. King of the second part Jacob Williams Matthew R. Pope and Sampson Pope of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by Gray, Williams and Matthew R. Pope three of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Jeremiah Chappell of the first part Thomas J. Hall of the second part and Thomas Hallton of the third part, conveying land and one half of a mill seat was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by Chappell and Thomas Hallton the other parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William Davis of the first part John Vick of the second part and James Vick of the third part, conveying slave horses and cattle was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by William Davis & son Vick two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
