The Commissioners appointed to view the lands through which it was proposed to opening a new road commencing near Capt Benjamin Griffin & running to &c near Zachariah Turner, this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded said report is in the words following to wit: "In conformity to the annexed order, we the undersigned Commissioners do hereby certify that we have viewed the ground on which it is proposed to open a new road say from the Pine Ridge road near Benjamin Griffin to the Quaker road at Zachariah Turner, and have come to the conclusion that a road opened through the road proposed will be of great benefit, not only to the people in the immediate neighbourhood, but to those living at a considerable distance, and in consequence of this belief, the neighbors have assembled together day after day and worked until they have opened and put in good repair the road as proposed in the annexed order, and we further report that it is the wish of the people generally that Eli Loring should be the surveyor of this new road, and that Nathaniel Turner should be the surveyor of that part of the Quaker Road that Eli Loring is now the surveyor of, and that the hands of Benj. Griffin, Jeremiah Loring, Eli Loring, John Camp, Gary Morrell & John Harris be put to work on the new road, which will take the hands off the old road in an equal proportion, and we now ask the Court to adopt the new Road as public highway agreeable to the above report. Given under our hands this 15th day of October 1842, Benj Griffin, Oley Loring, John Edwards "Commissioners" Whereupon the Court upon consideration of the said report doth adopt and establish the said new road as opened as a public highway."

Eli Loring is appointed surveyor of the new road commencing near Capt Benjamin Griffin and running near Zachariah Turner and it is ordered that the hands of Benj. Griffin, Jeremiah Loring, Eli Loring, John Camp, Gary Morrell and John Harris do work thereon.

Nathaniel Turner is appointed surveyor of that part of the road of which Eli Loring is surveyor in the name of the said Eli Loring, and it is ordered that the usual hands work thereon.

On the Motion of Charles Hark. Ordered that Benjamin Griffin who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, do state settle & adjust an account of the said Charles Hark administration on John Hark estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the Motion of Charles Hark. Ordered that Benjamin Griffin who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do state settle & adjust an account of the said Charles Hark administration on James Hark estate, and make report thereof to Court.
