For reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that the order heretofore made committing the estate of William A. Stone to the hands of the Sheriff for administration be set aside. And on the motion of Augustine L. Wells who made oath and together with John B. Mason James M. Williamson and John R. Chandler his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis moribus on the said William A. Stone estate in due form.
